PROSPECTUS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026 – 2027

HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL TIMINGS

(I) General Stream & Vocational Studies (XI and XII): 8.15am to 1.45pm
[after school 1 hr. lunch break followed by Remedial Classes for XII for 1 hour]

(II) Office Timings 9.30am to 4.30pm*
(*Lunch Break from 1.00pm to 1.30pm)

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

A student who desires to take admission to the institution should first read the prospectus carefully specially the subject details, fees structure and discipline matters. On the day of admission, the student should buy the Prospectus (admission form is attached to the prospectus) and fill in the required details.

After completion of the filling in of the form the student has to go to the respective stream hall for the teacher(s) in- charges verification and signature, then, the student has to proceed to pay the fees which need to be paid through scanning a QR code in the CAMPUS. CASH PAYMENT IS NOT ACCEPTED. Parent/Guardian must be accompanying the student who wants to seek admission.

Students seeking admission to standard XII, for the first time, should produce certificate of XI standard along with the school leaving certificate from the school last attended by him/her along with one certified copy of each.

All admissions are valid only for the current academic year and are required to be renewed by applying in the prescribed form for every subsequent year of study. **Admissions are provided on the basis of merit only.**

INCOMPLETE FORMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

Students who have passed the S.S.C. examination of the Goa Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education, Porvorim OR an equivalent Examination of any other recognized board are eligible for admission to the XI standard.

A student who has passed the S.S.C. or equivalent examination from other board except Goa Board and who desires to seek admission must obtain his/her leaving certificate countersigned by the District Education Officer of that state and has to comply with the eligibility certificate procedure which is an essential requirement as per the Goa Board rules within the stipulated time limit if not Late fee will be applicable.



Documents Required to be submitted during admission:

- 1. ORIGINAL LEAVING CERTIFICATE:** The original leaving certificate will not be returned. IF A STUDENT WISHES TO LEAVE THE INSTITUTION AFTER THE ADMISSION PROCESS IS COMPLETE, THEN HE/SHE WILL BE ISSUED THE LEAVING CERTIFICATE (of MES Hr. Sec. Sch.) AFTER 4 WEEKS FROM THE DATE OF THE ADMISSION.
- 2. Self-Attested Photocopy of the X standard Statement of Marks.**
- 3. CASTE CERTIFICATE:** Students who seek admission under the caste/class quota must be submitted in **original/attested copy.** [OBC certificates valid for 3 years].
CERTIFICATES ISSUED ONLY BY THE GOA GOVERNMENT ARE VALID.

STUDENT AID*

As part of the 50years celebration of Murgaon Education Society, a financial Aid is set up for the students who wish to seek admission in our institution (any Stream). This aid *will be for financially backward students* who cannot afford the fees of the school. Murgaon Education Society will contribute 75% of the tuition fees of these students. The desiring student will have to apply for the scheme and it has to be approved by the Student Aid Committee. **For further details kindly inquire during the admissions with the Principal or the Office.**

IDENTITY CARD

Every student shall be provided an Identity card which will have a recent photograph of the student which **must be worn** by the student on every working day. **Lost cards will be replaced only on payment of Rs. 100/- per card after the student informs the Principal in writing.**

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Readymade uniform sets will be available in the school campus during the time of admissions which will be sold at a **reasonable rate** with free adjustments (if needed) keeping with the school uniform pattern policy. Students are advised to have two pairs. **KINDLY NOTE THAT THIS UNIFORM WILL BE EXCLUSIVELY AVAILABLE ONLY IN THE CAMPUS during admissions.**

- All students will wear the prescribed uniform and modifications to the school uniform is not allowed.
- Proper school uniform also involves smart hairstyle and self - grooming.



3. Wearing of the school uniform in the school campus during the school hours is **COMPULSORY AND STUDENTS SHOULD STRICTLY ADHERE TO THIS.**
4. **Covering of the face and covering of the uniform is NOT PERMITTED during the classes within the school campus. (covering of the head by girls is permitted)**

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

IN ALL MATTERS of DISCIPLINE and SCHOOL RULES the PRINCIPALS decision SHALL BE FINAL AND BINDING upon every student.

1. Any Parent whose child/ward is studying in the higher secondary school can meet the Principal preferably between 12.00 noon to 2.00 pm or with prior appointment.
2. Parents should see that their children are regular in attendance, punctual and come to the school neat and tidy.
3. Parents/Guardians are not allowed to enter the classroom during school hours. In case of any emergency, they should contact the school office.
4. Results of each examination conducted by the school must be collected by the Parent/Guardian on the scheduled date.
5. Pupils are not permitted to remain in the classroom except during class hours. Exceptions need special permission.
6. Insubordination and unbecoming language or conduct is sufficient reason for the dismissal of a student.
7. **A student who does not come to school on any day or days must submit a note of absence stating the reason for absence and duly signed by the parent/guardian.**
8. **Absence at a single lecture/tutorial will be considered as absence for the whole day.**
9. **75% attendance is compulsory.**
10. An amount of Rs.20/- (rupees twenty only) will be collected as General Breakage amount from all the XI and XII standard science students for the Chemistry subject. However, if an expensive apparatus (worth above Rs. 200/-) is broken/damaged during his/her experiment, then the concerned student will have to pay half the cost of the broken/damaged apparatus.
11. Students found/reported defacing the walls/benches or any other school property will be fined, and disciplinary action will follow.
12. Students are forbidden from organizing association, webpages, social network sites, meetings, or fund raisers without the permission of the Principal.
13. No student should leave the premises in between without the prior permission of the class-teacher which may be given in case of genuine reason.



14. SMOKING, CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL OR ANY OTHER SUBSTANCE ABUSE, BURSTING OF FIREWORKS OR ANY HARMFUL ACT IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED IN AND AROUND THE SCHOOL CAMPUS.

15. The students will strictly abide by all the rules and regulations framed from time to time by the Principal or Management or by persons authorized by them in the school.
16. Students using the bikes/cars for travelling is purely the parents/guardians wish **HOWEVER the school will not be responsible for any accident/untoward incident with regard to the vehicle or two-wheeler.**
17. Use of Cell phones is strictly prohibited in the classroom, unless permitted by the teacher.

CO-CURRICULAR AND EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

N.S.S./N.C.C.(Army/Navy)/Y.R.C.: The students of General Stream can choose NSS or YRC and all the students of the school are eligible to choose NCC. However, a student gets the choice of only one of these subjects. **The student is not allowed to change the subject after XI.**



COMPUTER LABORATORY: The students will have access to the computer laboratory with prior permission of the teacher/instructor concerned.

SPORTS: The sports department provided facilities for certain indoor and outdoor games. Every attempt is made to provide the requisite sports material for developing the sportive talent of a student.

STUDENTS' COUNCIL: The students' council comprises of nominated representatives of the students from their respective classes. The President of the council i.e. the Principal shall appoint one or more chairperson(s) of the Students' Council and of the various associations. The teachers in charge/class teachers will nominate the appropriate student as Class Representative (C.R.) for their respective divisions. All teachers together with the Principal will nominate one student (boy or girl) as General Secretary (G.S.) and one girl student as Girls Representative (G.R.). **THERE ARE NO ELECTIONS AMONGST THE STUDENTS FOR ANY POST.**

Any member of the students council or the students council can be removed/disqualified by the principal in case he/she fails to perform his/her duties or if he/she acts in a manner not in consonant with the aims and objectives of the students council.

ASSOCIATIONS: The school has certain associations which intend to develop the various talents of the students, and they conduct various activities which will have the students organizing and participating in them under the guidance of faculty member.

PARENT-TEACHER ASSOICATION (P.T.A.): Parent-Teacher Association has been established in the school during the academic year 1990-91. The working committee has been formed to carry out various activities and to conduct periodic meeting. A general body meeting of the Association is held once a year.

CPSHW COMMITTEE

In accordance with the governments directive the school has instituted a "Vishakha commission" "*Committee for Prevention of sexual harassment of women at workplace*" (CPSHW) it is an endeavor of the committee to create and maintain a community in which students, teachers and non-teaching staff can work together in an environment free of violence, harassment, exploitation and intimidation.
